



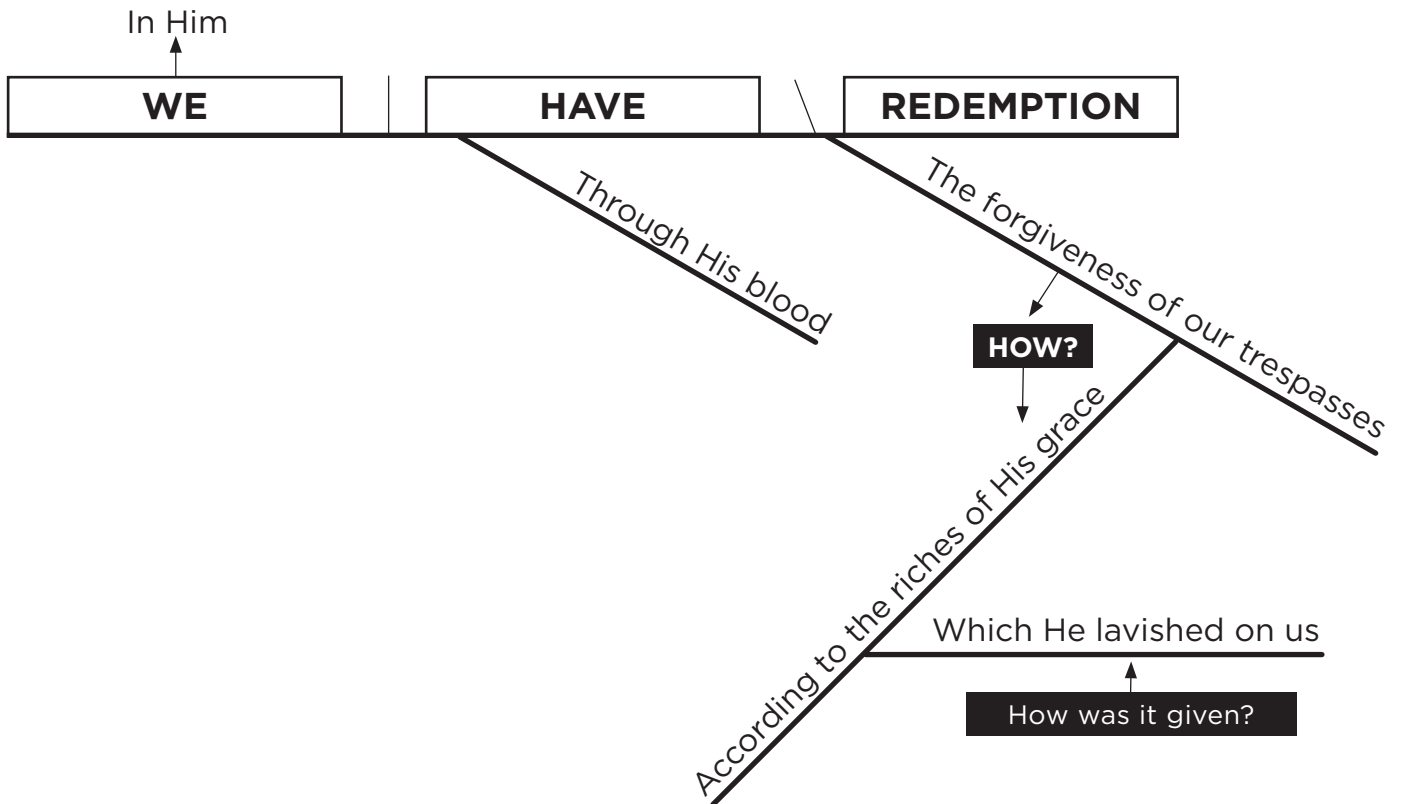
Three Questions

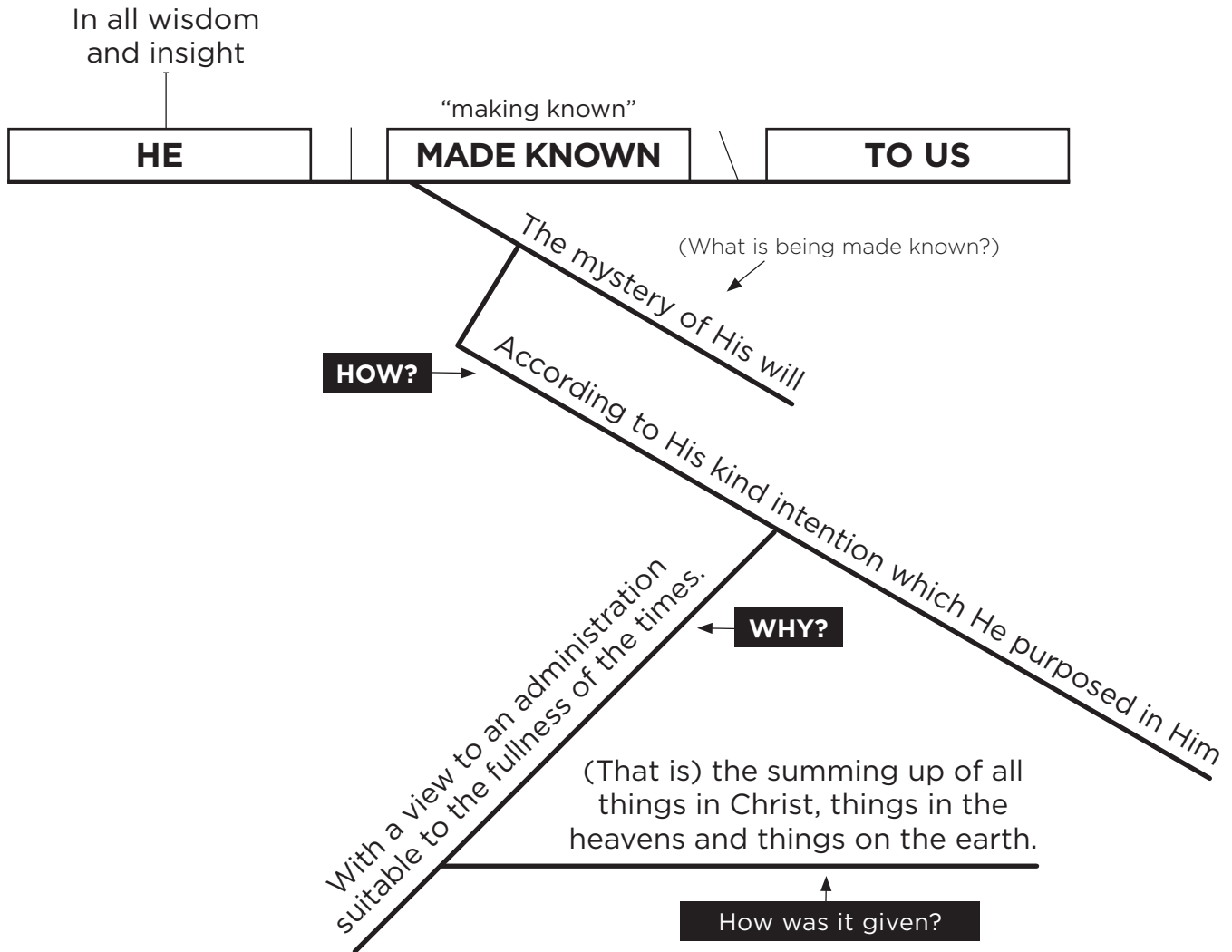
1. What does it say? OBSERVATION
