Fact #1:

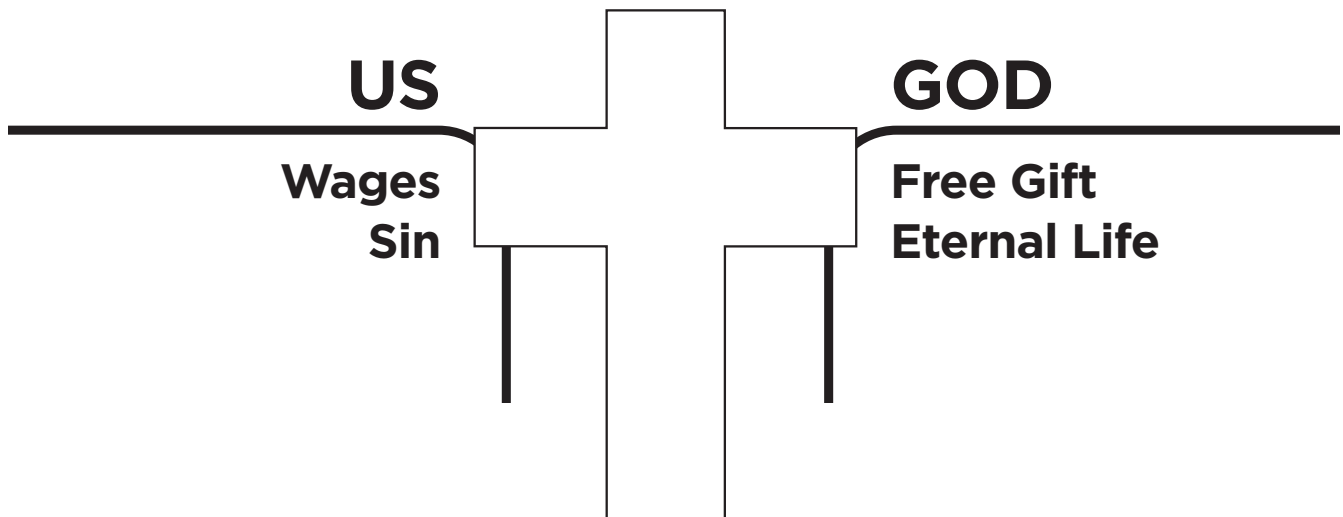
Christ is a conquering victor over sin, death, and Satan. The power to live a new life was made possible by His death and resurrection.

Principle #1: Life-change always begins with the truth.

Fact #2:

We become co-partakers of Christ's victory over sin, death, and Satan the moment we receive Christ as our personal Savior by faith.

Principle #2: Life-change demands that we act on the truth.



Fact #3:

Every believer is given a spiritual gift, a supernatural enabling, at the moment of salvation for two reasons: to remind us that life-change occurs on the basis of grace, not self-effort, and to empower us as other-centered agents of grace to build others up.

ASSIGNMENT
