The Habit of Being Diligent

Training Objective: Financial Stewardship (Work Ethic)

Training Command: “Steal no longer.”

Training Actions:

PUT OFF: Stealing

RENEW: Recognize the value and purpose of work.

PUT ON: Work unto the Lord
