JESUS' FINAL LESSON

MARK 11:20-13:37

Jesus never shied away from the hot topics of his day, but he also never let various factions frame the discussion for him. That's because, despite all the intellectual and religious arguments the experts made about following God's law, many missed the heart of it. Jesus saw the bigger picture, and He was at the center of it. He knew the driving force of the universe, and the primary reason it was created was love.

But not just any love. This was the unconditional, relentless, selfless love of God himself. And there are only two correct ways to respond to it, each connected to the other: to love him in return with everything in us and to overflow with that love toward other people.
